



# The setup

The top floor is 4 bedrooms 2 full bathrooms and a laundry room. The Biblical Accuracy room has a queen bed, twin size daybed and twin trundle. The Worship and Service rooms each have a queen bed. The Science room has two bunkbed sets with one having a full size bottom bunk. All beds have sheets, blankets and pillows, with the windows having room darkening curtains.

The bottom floor has 2 bedrooms, living room and a full bathroom. You walk down into the living room equipped with TV and DVD player, a shelf with games, reading materials, and DVD's. There is a bar height table with 6 chairs for playing games or talking over your day with a cup of coffee and quiet! There are 2 chairs and a twin size daybed with twin trundle. This daybed pops up to match heights with the day bed. A set of king sheets are in the laundry room, and extra blankets in the Biblical Authority rooms closet. The living room is separated from the next bedroom by 4 bar doors. The next bedroom has a queen bed, and full/twin bunk bed set. It opens onto a small patio and walks on to the backyard. There is a bench there for watching the fireflies at night. There is also a charcoal BBQ and fire pit. There are a few camp chairs in the garage as well. Smores in the backyard is a favorite! All the supplies (including firewood) can be found at Walmart. The 6th bedroom is connected to the full bathroom and has a twin/twin bunkbed set. The lights on the bottom floor have not been separated into the individual rooms yet – so one switch turns on the lights for all 3 rooms. There are lamps in the rooms for night time quiet.

Each bathroom has a shower/tub combo with full vanity. There are plenty of towels, handsoap and toilet paper for your stay. One bathroom is directly connected to the Biblical Authority room. The other opens into the hallway for the top floor. Each has a hair dryer.

The entry level floor opens into the living room complete with comfortable couches and chairs, TV and DVD player, and WiFi connection point. The Living room opens onto the deck overlooking the meadow like backyard. It also wraps around to the dining room with expandable table before the padded window seat with 4 chairs. Should you need more seating, there are additional 16 folding chairs and 2 8foot folding tables in the garage for your use. There is a small half bathroom attached to the kitchen.

The kitchen is equipped with dishes, bowls, glasses, mugs and silverware for 20. There is a full set of pots and pans, knives and cutting board, cooking utensils, serving bowls, colander, baking sheets and pans, pie pans, etc. We've tried to include everything to cook for a group of 20.

We've provided a coffee maker, hand mixer, electric skillet, Keurig, electric hot water pot, toaster, and an electric fondue pot (you never know when you will need this!).



## A few things to know

- No Pets. God created ALL creatures ~ including your beloved pets! But they are NOT welcome guests at the Getaway. We are allergic to animals!!! Please do not damage our ability to enjoy our own home by including your pets in your stay. We also keep the house 100% pet free to provide a space for immune compromised people who can not go to other places. Help us serve them. Do not bring your beloved animals.
- The house is equipped with full HVAC, including a separate system for the bottom floor. But the top floor does get hotter (in summer) and stay colder (in winter). There are ceiling fans in each room to help move air.
- 20 people use a lot of hot water. There is only one hot water tank (sorry this is an all electric house and a tankless option isn't available yet). Be mindful of when you wash dishes, do laundry and take showers.
- There are towel hooks in each bathroom and a drying rack in the laundry room.
- There are plenty of bath and hand towels. They can all be found in the laundry room.
- Move the furniture as suits your group. Please just return it to the room it came from when you leave.
- We do not take a security deposit from you up front, but we do ask you pay for any damages. We will let you know after your stay if we find something – but please let us know if something happens DURING your stay so we are prepared for the next guests coming. We aren't concerned about a broken glass, or stained towel here or there, but some repairs take time and need attention right away. Please give us the courtesy of letting us know as soon as you do!

## How it started

We came to Kentucky to visit the Ark when it first opened. We saw the need for places for people to stay while visiting -- especially families like ours with more than 4 people. We found the house on Humes Ridge Road -- loved it and decided to make a Kingdom Investment. But we weren't ready to put it all together to create a vacation rental yet.

In October 2016, we listed it for long term rental. After a while we were able to take part of the bottom floor space to create Iridescence Studio, with the help of Oscar and Brigitte Olano! We both had the same passion, to let families come to see this amazing testimony to the truth of the Bible. So after much work, in June 2018, we created an Art Studio for people to be able to purchase Artwork from the Ark's resident artist and have a place that is comfortable to stay if they had a little larger family. Oscar, the previous resident artist at the Ark, had partnered with us to decorate this space for this purpose. We put together the functional design and Oscar and Brigitte decorated and crafted the rest. The details, down to the original



lamps, are delightful! If you look around you will find items for sale now in the Ark that originated here (paintings as postcards, etc). It was a wonderful extension of your day at the Ark.

Then another change came and we had the whole house to use for families and groups. With some planning help from the City of Williamstown we were able to make some changes to the house so we could accommodate up to 20 people! We utilized some of the details we loved from the Studio ...Iridescence Getaway was started August 25, 2021!

We hope it works - our great experiment that is. We hope that you and your family build great memories and have conversations that deepen your faith. We hope that you go home refreshed and ready to serve and share. Mostly, we hope that we will meet you someday in God's Kingdom.

# General room instructions

## Passwords

\*\*\*We have had a lot of trouble using the apps on the TV (Pandora, PureFlik, etc) The easiest way to by pass the trouble is to plug a laptop into the TV using the provided HDMI cable. All the same apps can them be used and run through the TV. DVD's are also provided!

## Emergency contacts

For needs in the house: problems, supplies, etc. Contact Chris Barker 859.250.2644

## Lights

In the bottom floor the ceiling lights are all connected as one unit.

To have individual lights, there are lamps placed throughout the bottom floor rooms.

There is a porch light on a switch next to the door.

## Heat and Air Conditioning

There are two separate systems for Air Conditioning and Heating. The main level controls the whole house and the bottom level has an additional system that can be turned on with a remote control that stays on the wall.

Additionally the bottom floor has a portable heater in the closet and the top floor rooms are equipped with ceiling fans.

## Garbage

Garbage can be put in the large garbage cans on the garage. Cans are not sorted so garbage can be placed in any of the cans. Garbage is picked up on Wednesdays. Someone will pull it out some time on Tuesday and return it to the garage by Thursday.



# General room instructions

## Linens, etc

There are linens centrally available in the Laundry Room on the top floor. There is laundry detergent and fabric softener available if you would like to wash while here. Please wash white linens with ONLY white linens. There is a lint filter in the dryer that must be emptied between loads.

## Quiet Hours

All house guests are asked to observe quiet hours between 10 pm to 6 am. Please be respectful of our neighbors and the City of Williamstown. Please keep your joy contained for just the house to hear.

## Parking

The Getaway is approved (by the City of Williamstown) our house for a total of 6 vehicles. Please do not have more vehicles parked on the pad in front during your visit. If you need accommodations for more vehicles please contact us directly. There is overnight parking available at Walmart for sure.

Do not park on the grass, street or neighbors though.

## Fire Pit

There is an open wood fire pit and a charcoal BBQ. Sometimes there is wood on the patio you are welcome to use it. If there is charcoal or hickory chips or any other BBQ supplies in the garage you are welcome to use them.

You can get bamboo skewers from Walmart, easy and inexpensive. There are a few camp chairs stored in the garage to use around the pit or you can bring over the bench (just please put it back when you are done).

You may purchase wood or charcoal at Walmart. And when the night is over please put it all out with a lot of water. We don't keep matches or lighter fluid in the Getaway for safety reasons.



## TV and DVD usage

There is not any broadcast TV in the House. Samsung does offer a few channels. You may connect to the TV with

- your Bluetooth device or
- an HDMI cable or
- use the DVD player or
- connect with Pureflix, Amazon Prime or Pandora.

There is a remote for the TV and a remote for the DVD player. Both should be near the DVD player or on the cabinet beneath the TV.

The TV remote has fewer buttons, the buttons are generally all pictures (no words).

The DVD remote has lots of buttons, specifically 2 red buttons at the top.

If you are seeing the screen showing the DVD player – the DVD player is on and displaying. There is a selection of DVD's our family enjoys. Please just make sure to leave them behind for the next guest (sometimes they like to sneak into a computer DVD player and hide there).

Pureflix, and Pandora (music) are all available from the TV by pressing the **Home** button (picture of small house) from the TV remote.

Pureflix and Pandora are all free. Pureflix has a channel specifically of all *Answers in Genesis* videos. Pureflix *should* be connected through the TV. However... we have noticed it seems to get logged out and can't be reset easily. If you can open it, the account is **jamms@[aol.com](mailto:jamms@aol.com)** and password is **jamman**

Pandora channels are already created with our family's favorite Christian artists. You are welcome to create other channels, as well.

\*\*\*If you change the Samsung TV station, please return it to DOVE TV 1091 before you leave. This is a fairly safe channel for you viewers eyes.

\*\*\*If you disconnect a cord for some reason, please just reconnect it before you leave.

\*\*\*If you find the phantom TV turning on it is because something went to sleep and wasn't turned off. Turn off the TV specifically! If only the DVD player gets turned off the TV will look like it is off then suddenly turn on several minutes later.



# Bathrooms

## Water

There is only one hot water tank! Plan showers, laundry and dishes accordingly.

## Fan

After every shower, please run the fan for 60 minutes. This keeps humidity down in the house. Closing the door while the fan runs after showers also helps.

## Shower/Tub

To get the shower to run, turn the water on. The water will flow from the bathtub spigot. Pull down on the bottom of the spigot to stop the water flow and force it through the shower spigot.

There is a drain cover to catch hair during showers. This helps us maintain the house for other guests with less maintenance.

The upstairs master bathroom does have a working Jacuzzi Tub. Please fill the tub above the jets before you turn them on. If you use it, please let us know so we make sure to sanitize it before the next guests arrive.

## Laundry

Please wash only whites with whites.

As you have wet towels, please hang them up to dry before placing dirty ones in the laundry basket.

Sometimes emergencies happen when traveling with children. There are extra sheets in the Laundry Room. We do charge for linens left with bodily fluids. Please use the plastic twin size bedsheets if you have children prone to have accidents. And you are welcome to use the washer to appropriately clean linens as needed.

Put any soiled linens in the laundry tubs in the garage. They will be picked up after your stay. If you need further assistance, let us know – we understand things happen!!



# Checkout Instructions

- Pick up any used items, put things back where you found them, and take what you brought (we do not donate or use your left food items). If you need a vacuum for excessive occurrences, there is one in the Laundry Room.
- Remove used sheets from beds. Place them in the tubs in the garage. Leave mattress pads and comforters and used blankets on beds.
- Place bath towels and dirty hand towels in the tubs in the garage.
- Leave the Samsung TV channel set to 1091-Dove Channel.
- Take ALL the garbage out to the can in the garage.
- Wash and put away dishes. Any remaining dirty dishes? Fill the dishwasher and turn it on before you leave.
- If you move furniture between rooms, return it to the room it came from.
- Reset the Thermostat – 60 in the Winter and 80 in the Summer.
- Please leave the house neat and tidy!
- Turn off lights and equipment. Lock the doors



# How to Express Your Gratitude

## A.K.A House Rules

- Park only in the driveway and garage. Only 6 cars on the driveway. No parking on the street, grass or at neighbors houses.
- Quiet hours: 10 PM to 6 AM. Contain your joy to this house please!
- People, not pets! We love people to visit – and some of your special friends make it so our special friends can't come anymore (immune compromised kiddos).
- Only approved guests. We are careful about all we do to make your stay as economical and pleasant as we are able. Please honor us so we can honor you and others.
- Clean up messes. We have left mild cleaners under the kitchen sink, soaps for dishwashers, laundry, etc. and a vacuum in the Laundry Room. If something happens where you need extra help –please call Chris right away.
- No smoking on the property.
- If it's not legal elsewhere – it's not legal here.
- Please remember this house belongs to God. We use it for His glory. Please treat it as such.
